




## **A YEAR IN REVIEW**

## **FOREWARN®**


## SABOR LAUNCHES FOREWARN APP

SABOR announced a new member benefit, FOREWARN, to our SABOR REALTOR® members with an active MLS subscription. This new benefit comes at no cost to our members and is valued at \$240. The FOREWARN application gives an agent the ability to safely verify prospects (while not being exposed to any protected class information) with instant insight on a prospective client using only a phone number! Don't have a phone number you can also search by name.



## HOMESTEAD TAX EXEMPTION INCREASE

The San Antonio City Council approved an increase to the City of San Antonio's homestead tax exemption from 10% to the maximum allowed rate in Texas of 20%. SABOR Chair Sara Briseño Gerrish advocated on behalf of the organization in support of the measure. Sara emphasized the necessity of increasing the homestead exemption, highlighting that the additional tax savings could make a significant difference in residents' ability to afford mortgage payments, utility bills and ultimately retain ownership of their homes.



## NEW REALTOR® STORE

The San Antonio Board of REALTORS® opened their newly renovated REALTORS® Store in 2023. Inside you can find plenty of for-sale signs, REALTOR® merchandise such as mugs and hats, lockboxes and more. The newly-renovated store is the perfect stop for our members to quickly grab the items they need when performing a transaction or listing a new home for sale. The store offers snacks and drinks as well for those on-thego. The REALTORS® Store at SABOR is the only one-stop shop for REALTOR® items in San Antonio.



#### **HAR Data Share**

Launched the Datashare between SABOR MLS and the Houston Association of REALTORS®, the first of its kind in the state.

## Section 5 Amendment

Amended Section 5 of the Rules and Regulation to allow members to offer \$0 or greater in their Offer of Compensation.

## Section 1 Amendment

Amended Section 1 of the Rules and Regulations to allow members to list sections of a larger parcel before the appraisal district subdivides the property.

## Section 9.2 Amendment

Amended Section 9.2 of the Rules and Regulations regarding Lockbox Violations. Members of the committee agreed to increase the amount of the fines for the safety of homeowners and fellow REALTORS®.

#### Residential Rental Fields

Updated and created fields in Residential Rental for agents to articulate to a buyer what fees are associated with renting a home with an animal.

#### **New Fields**

Added fields like Senior Community and Other Structures for members to be able to indicate certain needs for their clients.

### Updated Bedroom & Bathroom Terms

Update all Master Bedrooms and Bathrooms to an industry appropriate term Primary Bedroom and Bathrooms.

#### **MLS Task Force**

Reviewed competing MLS products CoreLogic Matric and Black Knight Paragon Connect. Task Force decided to keep our existing vendor, dynaConnections

ConnectMLS.

#### Reciprocal Lockbox Agreements

Entered a lockbox reciprocal agreement with the Houston Association of REALTORS and Victoria Area Association of REALTORS allowing SABOR MLS subscribers access to the SUPRA lockboxes in those areas.



Hosted many interviews with local candidates seeking election to offices within the city of San Antonio and Bexar County.




Worked with Elected officials on Housing and property rights related issues.
